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To Whom It May Concern,

All generations of the SeQual Eclipse portable oxygen concentrator are FAA approved to be used on board an Aircraft.

The approvals listed by the FAA are for the "SeQual Eclipse". They do not reference any specific model or generation of the product. Approvals apply to the Eclipse 1 (Model 1000), Eclipse 2 (Model 1000A), Eclipse 3 (Model 1000B), and the new Eclipse 5. All Eclipse concentrators are classified as the "Eclipse Oxygen System" on their labels, regardless of generation.

There is no need for additional FAA documentation that specifically references the "Eclipse 5", just as there was no statement in the approval documents that referenced the Eclipse 1, 2, or 3 models. The FAA does not require a change to these documents upon the release of a new generation because it still falls under the "Eclipse Oxygen System" model name.
